

## **Supervised Outdoor Visits**

Dear Families and Friends,

We know that you are missing your loved ones and that they are missing you. We would like to see you enjoy time with one another. We have been working on ways to ensure safe "supervised" visiting methods that meet the requirements mandated by the government.

Scheduled visits will begin on June 27<sup>th</sup> and will occur every Tuesday, Wednesday, Saturday and Sunday between the hours of 11am and 7pm (meal times excluded). Please note that visits may be cancelled at any time due to inclement weather or to meet the operational needs of the home.

With the nice weather upon us, we have designated an outdoor visiting area for you and your loved one for safe visiting.

- Please book an appointment by calling our Activity Director, Nicole Hopper.
- Each resident may receive one visit with one visitor per week. If additional space is available, additional visits may be booked.
- We will be booking 30-minute visitation sessions to try and accommodate all requests during the week
- The visiting area will be cleaned and disinfected between every visit
- Please do not arrive until 5 minutes before your scheduled visit We ask you do not arrive too early so you are not crossing paths with other visitors
- Visitors are to ensure physical distancing (2m/6') with others on the site, no physical contact is to be made
- . Visitors will be required to pass screening and have proof of a negative covid test completed within 2 weeks of the scheduled visit. This has been directed by the government.
